

Grant Portal Registration Guide

GP2 is leveraging The Michael J. Fox Foundation's (MJFF) grants infrastructure for this initiative. All full proposals must be submitted through the [MJFF Grant Portal](#). If you have applied for funding through the MJFF Grant Portal, log in using your credentials. If you need to reset your password, click the Forgot Password button.

GETTING STARTED – NEW GRANT PORTAL USERS

If you have never applied to an ASAP or MJFF RFA, click the “Register Here” button.
Search for your organization in the “Organization Name” field.
If your organization is not found, click “Add New Organization” and complete the organization information.
Complete the “Contact Information” fields. Be sure to use an active email address.
Click the “Submit” button.
You will receive an email to the provided email address.
Follow the instructions in that email to set a password and log in to the Grant Portal.

How To Apply in the Grant Portal

1. Once logged in, click the “Funding Opportunities” icon.
2. Find “GP2 Underrepresented Populations PhD Program 2024” and click “Apply for Funding”
3. Follow the instructions to complete the required fields. Please note the following:
 - a. **“Project Title” is not applicable for this call.** Please write “N/A” in this field.
 - b. **Supervisor Name is not applicable for this call.** You may leave this field blank or write “N/A”.
 - c. **Bank Letter and W8/W9 are not applicable for this call.** You may ignore these fields.

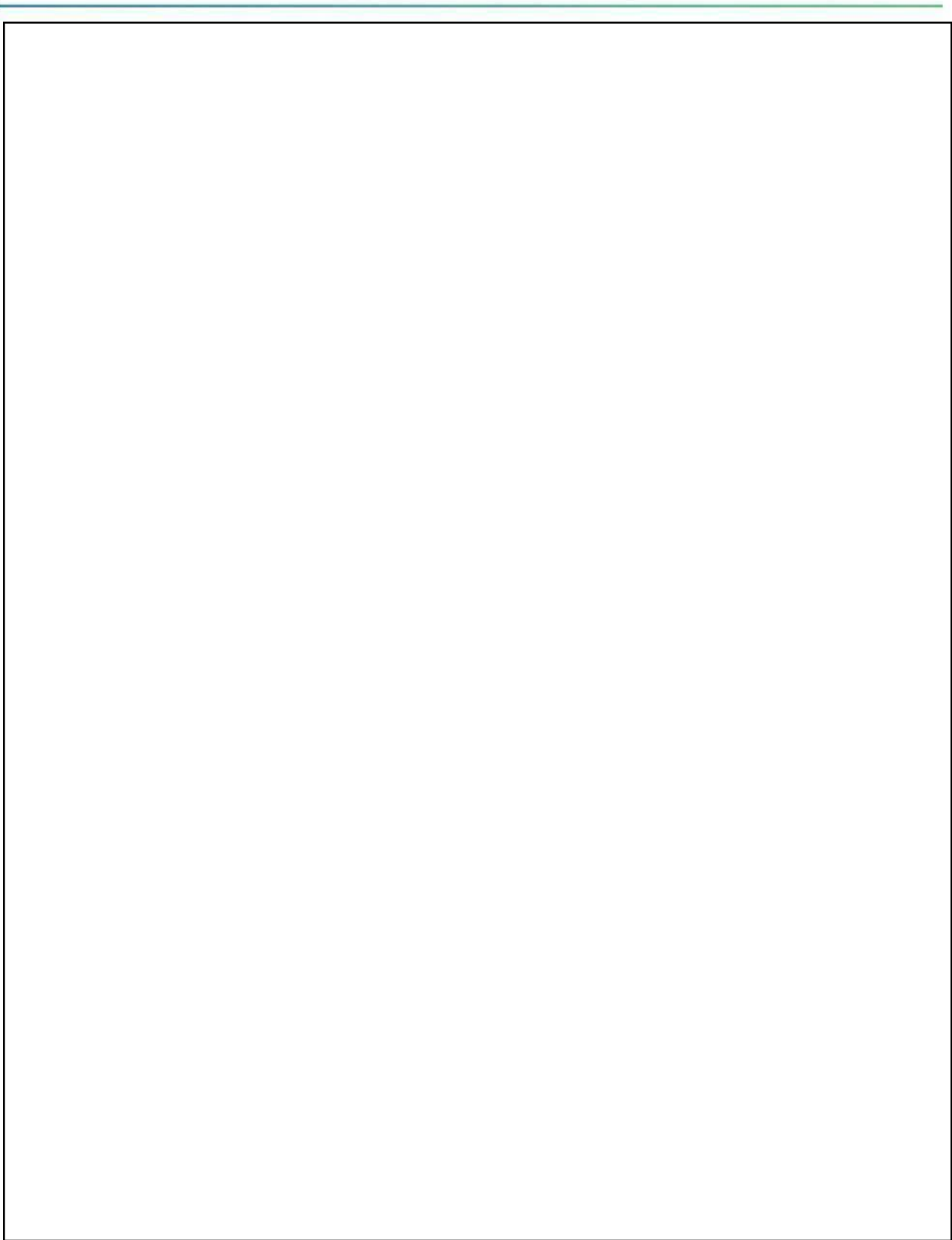
